Project progress update

We are pleased to announce that in May 2024, the Victorian Planning Minister made a decision on our environmental 'Referral' through an announcement on the Department of Transport and Planning website.

This means that we can begin work on the project's Environmental Effects Statement (EES). This is likely to take around two years and will involve detailed studies on potential impacts including on flora and fauna, Aboriginal and cultural heritage, noise and traffic among other things.

The next stage is the agreement of the 'Scoping Requirements' which is the key issues that we will study, which will also be published on the Department's website once agreed and signed off.

Thibault has worked with Neoen for 3 years, starting in the Paris office and joining the Victorian team in Melbourne about 9 months ago. We look forward to introducing you to him.

Naomi, our Community Liaison Officer, will be at the playground in Navarre if you wanted to drop by and ask any questions about the project or have a chat in person.


